SOCIAL QUEEN trailed early then between rivals on the backstretch, advanced outside nearing the quarter pole and joined the leaders leaving the furlong grounds then proved best to the wire. CHESTORIA advanced outside on the final turn, reached the pacesetter in midstretch and put a head in front nearing the sixteenth pole then continued on gamely while unable to resist the top one. MIRACLE MOMENT rated on the pace, saved ground and responded when asked then weakened in the drive. CZARINA'S GIRL well placed while saving ground, lacked the needed response. MADDY'S HEART in good position early while just off the inside, lacked the needed bid. MEDLEY (GB) stalked early, was asked on the final turn, raced along the inside entering the lane and weakened in the drive. MONTECITO (GB) saved ground and lacked a response. BEATRIX KIDDO (FR) broke a bit slowly and a bit rank early, raced outside into the backstretch and also lacked a response.
