EBLOUISSANTE saved ground off the pace, came out into the second turn, moved up three wide on that turn and into the stretch, bid alongside the leader under left handed urging in midstretch, gained the advantage approaching the sixteenth pole and won clear. CHESTNUT MOON stalked inside to the stretch, came out off the heels of the pacesetter for room nearing the sixteenth pole and went around that rival late for the place. SATURDAY NITE RIDE sped to the early lead, angled in on the first turn, set the pace inside, came out into the stretch, fought back in midstretch, drifted inward a sixteenth out and lost second late. BELONGING pulled between horses then chased outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and bested the others. SPIN THE BLUES broke a bit slowly, settled inside then just off the rail into and on the second turn and did not rally. URANIA pulled her way along and stalked off the rail, was between horses into the stretch and weakened. PLAYFUL HUMOR angled in and chased outside a rival, split horses early on the backstretch, continued a bit off the rail into and on the second turn and could not offer the necessary response. OUT FOR REVENGE chased outside then three deep on the backstretch, dropped back into the second turn and gave way.
