ACCLAMATION took the lead three deep in the chute, angled in outside a rival and set the pace a bit off the rail, responded when JERANIMO bid on the backstretch, inched away into the second turn and drew clear in the stretch under a tap of the whip, a brisk hand ride and a long hold late. JERANIMO had speed inside then stalked the winner, bid inside that one on the backstretch, tracked that rival into and on the second turn, came out into the stretch and just held second. CARACORTADO four wide in the chute, angled in entering the main course, chased three deep on the first turn then off the rail, came out in the stretch and just missed the place. SMART BID stalked between horses on the first turn then a bit off the rail, came out some in the stretch and was edged for third. LEROY'S DYNAMEAUX settled a bit off the fence then outside a rival, continued off the rail on the second turn and did not rally. GOLDWAKI (GER) squeezed a bit just after the start, saved ground throughout to no avail and had little left for the stretch.
