LA CORONEL was unhurried early along the six path, fanned into the eight path entering the lane, rallied down the lane wide, ranged up making a bid with the entry mate and edged past in the final stages. DREAM DANCING raced back early on from the three path, waited nearing the quarter pole, fanned into the seven path entering the lane, split horses at the top of the lane, made a bid, took over and led late inside the sixteenth pole but was ran down by the entry mate in the final stages. SWEEPING PADDY tracked the pace early along the four path, shifted into the three path in the far turn, took the lead into the lane, inched clear inside the eighth pole but faltered late in the drive. PROCTOR'S LEDGE chased the pace early from the six path, shifted out a bit wider while making a bid but flattened out late in the stretch run. EMPHATICALLY raced back early on along the five path, fanned into the nine path in the turn while making a bid but leveled out down the lane. STORM THE HILL hopped at the start and trailed the field early from the three path, stayed in the three path entering the lane and moved up in the stretch drive. INDIA MANTUANA exchanged bumps into the first turn, stalked the pace from the five path, stayed in the five path in the far turn while making a bold bid but faded late in the stretch. JOURNEY HOME steadied a bit early on, fanned into the five path in the far turn and was empty down the lane. PURELY A DREAM was done early along the five path. STALLION HEIRESS set the pace early along the three path, shifted into the four path in the far turn and gave way in the stretch. BERNADIVA was through after a half. YOU MISSED IT was never involved. YOUNGEST DAUGHTER exchanged bumps into the first turn, chased the pace off the rail, swung into the six path entering the lane and was tired in the stretch.
