By subscription of \$150 each to accompany the nomination, or by supplementary nomination of \$3,000 by the time of entry. \$750 to pass the entry box and \$750 additional to start with \$150,000 Guaranteed, of which \$90,000 to the winner, \$30,000 to second, \$18,000 to third, \$9,000 to fourth and \$3,000 to fifth. Weight, 120 lbs. Non-winners of \$75,000 at one mile or over allowed 3 lbs.; \$50,000 allowed 5 lbs.; (Maiden, claiming and starter races not considered). First preference will be given to highweights. Second preference will be given to horses with highest total earnings. High weights preferred. Closed Thursday, February 28, 2008 with 25 nominations and 1 supplement. (Clear 66)

AUTISM AWARENESS broke alertly and settled in just behind the leaders and stalked them to the second turn, was boxed behind the leaders at the five sixteenth and waited, finally got outside PLEASURE GROUNDS in the upper stretch, responded to gain command in mid stretch and won driving. NIKKI'SGOLDENSTEED bobbled at the start but recovered and raced up to the lead into the first turn, gave up the advantage when he went to jumping shadows near the seven eighths pole then continued to jump them into the backstretch but prompted TRES BOARRACHOS from the rail, took a slim advantage at the five sixteenths pole, dueled well into the stretch then dug back in late and was coming back on. TRES BORRACHOS dueled outside NIKKI'SGOLDENSTEED early, continued to battle for the lead between horses into the lane and gradually weakened. PLEASURE GROUNDS stalked the dueling leaders three wide early, remained out and moved up to challenge for command on the second turn, appeared to gain a short advantage at the furlong pole but faltered in the final eighth. BEHINDATTHEBAR settled early from off the rail, raced three wide on the second turn while in mid pack, shifted out leaving the furlong pole and was actually coming on late. DREAMED DAY was void of any early speed, raced just off the rail on the second turn and finished in a mild rally. MASTER DANIEL settled early three wide, was four wide on the second turn and did not rally. COAST GUARD raced unhurried three wide, saved ground to rally to the upper stretch then gave out. GENERAL DAN was never a serious factor.
