Chestnut Colt, (Apr), by Giant's Causeway - Satin Sunrise by Mr. Leader. Trainer Pletcher A. Todd. Bred by Commonwealth(KY). CONNEMARA was permitted to trail to the half mile pole, commenced a bid after easing widest, closed ground four wide to the stretch then drew even in mid stretch and pushed clear in the final sixteenth. HAIMISH HY was under a snug hold early, was outrun by rivals into the second turn, came three wide to the stretch, angled out in mid stretch for room and closed willingly in the late stages. POSSE POWER settled off the pace to the half mile pole, bid two wide on the second turn, was blocked leaving the bend into the stretch and waited, eased out then was blocked again leaving the furlong grounds, checked and shifted out then finished well once clear. FOG ALERT chased the pace to the second turn, rallied three wide to join the leaders to the stretch, had a short lead to mid stretch but could not hold on and was outfinished. RANGER HEARTLEY set the pace for six furlongs, responded to pressure to mid stretch then tired in the late stages. THOMAS BAINES was rank and hard to place under a rating hold on the first turn, pressed the pace to the second turn, saved ground to the stretch then was caught behind rivals and forced to steady at mid stretch and could not regain the needed momentum. VERY FAIR prompted the pace to the half, responded to urging on the second turn but weakened in the final furlong. BERT' N THE GROUP had no speed, was three or four wide throughout then gave way through the stretch. OUR MINESWEEPER settled mid pack then had nothing to offer when roused and stopped.
