Chestnut Gelding, (Apr), by Castledale (IRE) - Sandtina by Sandpit (BRZ). Trainer Kassen C. David. Bred by Richard Sherman(KY). NIKKI'S SANDCASTLE broke well and angled over two wide off the rail in the first turn, allowed to settle in near the back of the pack, steadily began to advance position in the backstretch, raced five in the turn, edged up to leaders at the top of the lane, asked to pick it up midstretch, responded gamely, kicked in and held clear late. KHARAFa raced along the inside heading into the first turn, continued to save ground stalking along the inside, began to advance position in the backstretch, urged between rivals at the top of the lane, edged up to the lead, matched strides with rivals in the late drive, continued to dig in but could not get by NIKKI'S SANDCASTLE. SALTO (IRE) raced along the inside in the first turn, continued to stalk front runners, edged up to the leaders heading into the turn, vied for the late lead with rivals and lacked a final kick in the late drive. EMPIRE BUILDER raced two wide on the backstretch and stalked the early front runners, made a bid nearing the far turn and continued steady bid in the stretch. HOOFIT (NZ) was reserved in the early going, continued two wide near the back in the backstretch, asked to pick it up heading into the final turn and gained ground in the stretch. BAD DEBT allowed to settle in along the inside in the first turn, continued to save ground along the inside in the backstretch, steadily began to gain ground, raced within contention in the stretch but lacked late needed kick in the late drive. BEAU CHOIX raced in the back of rivals in opening stages and passed tiring rivals two to three wide in the stretch. ZIMMER allowed to settle in early stages, continued to race evenly in the backstretch and lacked late needed rally in the stretch. GET SERIOUS saved ground racing along the inside early stages and failed to make an impact in the stretch. TEAKS NORTH raced two wide in the backstretch and lacked late needed response. XIN XU LIN (BRZ) urged up to take the early lead, led by a slight margin on the backstretch and steadily began to weaken heading into the far turn. TUNE ME IN raced up close along the inside, tracked the leader, briefly edged up to the lead quarter pole and steadily began to falter. HOBBS raced up close and tracked the top two front runners, began to falter in the backstretch.
