FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD WHICH HAVE STARTED FOR A CLAIMING PRICE OF \$25,000 OR LESS SINCE JANUARY 1, 2007. WEIGHT: Three-year-olds, 117 lbs; Older, 124 lbs. Fillies and Mares allowed 5 lbs. Non-winners of three races for an allowance purse or for a starter or claiming price of \$40,000 or greater since January 1, 2007 allowed 2 lbs; of two races for an allowance purse or for a starter or claiming price of \$32,000 or greater since January 1, 2007 allowed 4 lbs; of a race for an allowance purse or f or a starter or claiming price of \$32,000 or greater since January 1, 2007 allowed 6 lbs. SELF MADE MAN tracked just off the leaders in hand in the opening half, steadily drew into striking position on the second bend, bid three wide nearing upper stretch, then edged SHIPWATCH in the final stages under strong handling. The latter secured a forward placing on the rail in the opening quarter, asserted himself to dictate the tempo into the backstretch, turned back several challenges racing into upper stretch, resisted the winner grudgingly to the end but came up second best. CANARD ducked out at the start, was quickly collected and guided to the inside, made steady progress racing through the far turn to gain contention but was no match for the top pair. ONOTHEREGOSTOKYO, reserved in hand in the opening stages, shifted out on the far turn while drawing into contention, shifted out four deep entering upper stretch and continued to make mild progress to the end. MR PLAYWRIGHT was guided to the rail tracking the pace in the opening half, advanced to lodge a brief challenge entering the far turn but lacked the needed final response. CHIP HUNTER was rated along the inside early but never gained striking distance. POR FAVOR joined the pace between foes in the opening quarter, drifted outwards on the first turn impeding a rival, continued well wide on the backstretch and soon gave way. GALLO DEL BAR (CHI) raced unhurried outside foes to the backstretch, made some progress nearing the far turn, was carried five wide entering the far turn and quickly faded from contention. SWITZERLAND was carried out a bit racing through the first turn, came around a drifting rival on the backstretch to press the pacesetter for six furlongs and gave way abruptly in upper stretch.
