KEY TO POWER was taken in hand and raced in or near the back of the field, continued full of run leaving the backstretch, quickly gained ground along outside running around far turn, raced five wide at head of the lane, asked for more, responded gamely and kicked by in late drive.

ROMAN APPROVAL was allowed to settle along outside running through the backstretch, picked up pace leaving three eighths pole,

continued patiently then given cue at head of the lane, kicked in, took over the lead but could not hold off eventual winner in late drive and held

place. GHOST HUNTER was unhurried in early going, gained ground along inside, lacked room in the far turn, split foes at furlong marker, kept

on with strong kick and just missed place in final stride. SCRUMPDILICIOUS was forwardly placed in early going then edged up to engage rival

for the lead, vied three wide in the far turn, continued to battle between into upper stretch, could not move on with rivals and flattened out in final

furlong. PURELY BOY was allowed to settle in the backstretch, made move three furlongs out, dug in between rivals at head of the lane, gained

ground then finished evenly in late drive. YANKEE DEALER stalked pace racing between rivals in the backstretch, raced off top pair then moved

up along rail, dueled midway in the far turn, continued to battle into the lane and gaveway in final furlong. DEPECHE CHAT stalked pace along the

outside, came under ride racing off top flight in the far turn, continued urging entering the lane, could not sustain bid and lost position. FLASHY CHELSEY was reserved in the backstretch, hustled up leaving the backstretch, dug in along rail at the guarter pole, continued bid head of the

lane then flattened out. UNCLE DAVE raced up close in the early going, could not keep up pace, steadily faded along the inside. LAYTHATPISTOLDOWN fanned out wide in the first turn, took over the lead and led the way in early backstretch, challenged and dueled three

furlongs out, could not match strides with rivals and faded in the lane. ESCONDIDO tracked pace along the rail, lacked response after the half, dropped back. BERN' JAMES BERN raced five wide in first turn, raced in back and forced to be taken up to avoid fallen rival at quarter pole.
