EFFINÉX broke in a step at the start bumping lightly with BEAUTYINTHEPULPIT, settled just off the inside in mid pack, came under urging

past the five-sixteenths, cut the corner into upper stretch in behind the leader, angled out a path at the three-sixteenths, rallied with good kick to

get on nearly even terms nearing the sixteenth marker, poked a nostril in front seventy yards to the finish besting a stubbornly game foe inside

him to prevail. SO LONESOME broke out at the start bumping EYE LUV LULU, showed the way in hand along the inside, remained patiently

handled until roused cutting the corner into upper stretch, dug in stubbornly coming under threat nearing the sixteenth marker, fought on inside his main rival gamely to the end but was caught inside the final seventy yards and forced to settle for the place. BEAUTYINTHEPULPIT

bumped at the start lightly by EFFINEX when that foe broke in a step, settled two to three wide towards the rear, came under encouragement past the three-eighths pole, cornered three wide into upper stretch, offered up late foot to garner the show. SARATOGA SNACKS three to four wide in mid pack, got put to encouragement at the five-sixteenths, angled five wide into upper stretch, weakened in the late stages. EYE LUV

LULU bumped at the start by SO LONESOME breaking outwards, got lightly coaxed along just off the inside in close range of the leader, came under a ride at the five-sixteenths, spun two to three wide at the quarter pole, weakened in the final eighth. AWESOME VISION broke a bit awkward at the start, settled three to four wide towards the rear, came under urging at the seven-sixteenths, angled five to six wide into upper

stretch, passed tired foes in the lane. SIOUX three wide in range of the front, got placed to encouragement at the five-sixteenths, angled four wide for home, tired in the stretch. SINISTRA tracked the pace inside in aim, came under a ride at the five-sixteenths in retreat, cut the corner

into upper stretch and faltered. EMPIRE DREAMS three wide towards the rear, got ridden along three furlongs from home, cornered four wide into upper stretch, made no impact.
