The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. PRINCESS VIOLET settled in midpack after the start, sat reserved in the two path for the initial three-quarters, got cued up and started to cross the command spinning about four wide into the stretch, wrested away control in short order, scampered away under a hand drive while crossing the finish line. FLIPCUP made solid contact with SUNNY DESERT, rode the rail for six furlongs, was angled three wide into the stretch, rallied willingly to garner the place. CARAMEWAY in the three path, pressed the issue outside a twosome for over three-quarters, remained a prominent factor before weakening in the final furlong. LADY GRACENOTE took the inside route for most of the way along the backstretch, departed it from the two path, swung wider and wider after entering the stretch until in the vicinity of the eight path, closed in willingly after completing the move to grab the last major check. STORIED LADY chased the pace from the two path, unleashed an abbreviated run from the quarter pole to midstretch, then flattened out. UNBELIEVABLE DREAM took up the chase from the three path on the turn, was six wide leaving the three-sixteenths marker, made no headway. DREAMING OF CARA three wide midway on the turn, was in the seven path midway through the furlong grounds, had no rally. SUNNY DESERT bumped hard with its neighbor to the right?at the start, raced as a teammate of PENNYMINE during the opening stages, had CARAMEWAY make it a three wide pace dispute shortly afterwards, disputed the pace from between rivals for nearly six furlongs then gave way. PENNYMINE vied for command from the inside, stopped.
