DREAMING OF ANNA away alertly, set a solid pace under good handling, settled into the stretch with a clear lead then continued gamely when challenged to just last over LEAR'S PRINCESS late. LEAR'S PRINCESS stalked the pace inside for more than six furlongs, angled off the rail into the furlong grounds then finished strong to just miss. MERIBEL was unhurried early, advanced inside after five furlongs then got through along the rail in the furlong grounds and was also gaining late. PRETORIA LIGHT stalked the pace early, bid three wide leaving the second turn then weakened under pressure. BEAUTIFUL VENUE chased to the stretch then gave way. JAUNTY GALE made a mild middle move through the second turn then came up empty. PATRICIA (ARG) failed to menace. THE REAL FUTURE was through early. TIGER BELLE showed little.
