1 1/4 MILES. (1.47) STAKES. Purse \$200,000 (Includes \$50,000 BC - Breeders' Cup) *EXCELSIOR S. (GRADE III) FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD.* No nomination fee. \$1,500 to pass the entry box. All starters will receive a \$1,000 rebate. This race includes an additional \$50,000 in Breeders' Cup Funds for Cup nominees only. The NYRA purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. Three year olds, 115 lbs. Older 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$90,000 at a mile or over in 2009-2010 allowed 2 lbs.; a graded sweepstake at a mile or over since September, allowed 4 lbs.; \$60,000 since then or \$40,000 in 2010 allowed 6 lbs. (Maiden, claiming, starter and restricted allowance races not considered). Breeders' Cup Fund monies also correspondingly divided providing a Breeders' Cup nominee has finished in an awarded position. Any Breeders' Cup Fund monies not awarded will revert back to the Fund. A Trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, March 20, 2010 with 25 Nominations. (Cloudy 49)

GOLDSVILLE pressed the pace from outside for most of the way, angled out to launch his bid at the quarter pole, surged to the front a furlong out then edged clear under steady right hand urging. NITE LIGHT was well placed along the rail for six furlongs, saved ground advancing into the stretch then finished strongly along the rail to narrowly gain the place. SENIORS PRIDE sprinted clear on the rail, set the pace in hand for seven furlongs, battled heads apart into midstretch and yielded in deep stretch. MORE THAN A REASON was reserved for a half, moved out on the far turn, made a three wide move to threaten nearing the quarter pole but couldn't sustain his rally. STARGLEAM trailed after breaking a bit slowly, raced in hand along the rail to the turn, angled out and lacked a late response.
