OSCAR NOMINATED set the pace on the inside, was asked in the two path at the guarter-pole, came under a left-handed whip in upper stretch, dueled on the inside of the winner and missed while able to get the place. ONE MEAN MAN was well placed while saving ground, drafted along the rail on the far turn, shifted three wide while asked at the quarter-pole, drifted out under a drive in the stretch and lacked the needed kick while just able to get the show. BULLARDS ALLEY saved ground on the first turn, settled off the pace, raced inside on the far turn, was asked in the two path turning into the stretch, was put to a right-handed whip near the three-sixteenths and finished willingly to just miss the show. GRANNY'S KITTEN bobbled at the start, raced in the two path on the first turn, was rated under a tight hold, went two then three wide on the far turn, swung five wide while roused into the stretch, was carried out by ONE MEAN MAN in the drive and lacked the needed response. GOLDEN SOUL went three wide on the first turn, was rated on the outside, chased three wide on the far turn, spun four wide into the stretch and weakened. BLAME ANGEL raced inside on the first turn, lagged well behind the rest of the field, was urged along while inside on the far turn, swung three wide into the stretch and failed to threaten.
