TOUCH OF CLASS prompted the leaders while racing just off the rail, angled out at the top of the stretch and finished willingly to gain the place. SHESAGRUMPTOO was rank just after the start, swung four wide for the turn, gained position while finishing evenly through the lane. BEAR'SLITTLEBEAUTY set a pressured pace along the rail, lost the lead at the quarter pole, continued to battle the winner around the turn, gave way in upper stretch. NANA LOUISE was off a step slow, trailed throughout. EQUIPMENT: NANA LOUISE did not wear front shoes.
