By subscription of \$150 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$7,500 at time of entry (Includes entry and starting fees). \$750 to enter and an additional \$750 to start, with \$150,000 guaranteed, of which \$93,000 to the owner of the winner, \$30,000 to second, \$15,000 to third, \$7,500 to fourth and \$4,500 to fifth. Weight: Three year olds, 122 lbs.; Older, 125 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I over a mile in 2006 allowed 2 lbs.; a Grade I over a mile in 2005-2006 allowed 4 lbs.; a Grade III at a mile or over in 2006 or \$60,000 twice at a mile or over in 2005-2006, 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. A gold julep cup will be presented to the owner of the winner. Closed Wednesday, October 18, 2006 with 30 nominations. Chestnut Gelding, (Mar), by Most Welcome (GB) - Sure Care (GB) by Caerleon. Trainer Attfield L. Roger. Bred by A. S. Reid(GB).

ECCENTRIC (GB) settled near the inside early, was never far back, was steadied lightly behind SOUTHERN AFRICA approaching the final quarter, remained near the rail when that one moved out, then was hard ridden to prevail. BALL FOUR went up to vie for the lead early while three or four wide, took over just before going a quarter, drew clear on the backstretch, edged closer to the inside on the far turn, maneuvered three or four wide into the lane, lost the advantage to the winner from the inside leaving the furlong grounds and continued on with good courage to earn the place. GOOD REWARD, reserved early and taken in behind horses, four wide, moved six wide on the far turn to secure room, came eight wide into the stretch, gained never even terms for the lead leaving the eighth pole but couldn't sustain the needed momentum. A. P. ARROW was returned to the paddock for a shoe repair. During the running, A. P. ARROW followed the pace five wide, lost a bit of position on the far turn, came out nine wide into the stretch and offered a mild gain. HOST, within easy striking distance while between foes three or four wide into the upper stretch, was steadied at the three-sixteenths, moved closer to the inside soon after but couldn't muster the needed response. SCIPION, taken in hand early and maneuvered in four wide while outrun, moved out six wide on the backstretch, edged in on the far turn to be near the rail entering the stretch, then improved position. KID GRINDSTONE, outrun to the stretch, came to the extreme outside to be ten or twelve wide and improved position. STUDENT COUNCIL raced within easy striking distance while between rivals four or five wide to the head of the stretch and flattened out. WAYZATA BAY followed the leaders in a striking position five wide until nearing the stretch and weakened. SOUTHERN AFRICA, in front after the start, raced forwardly near the inside into the upper stretch and faltered. ALUMNI HALL, in contention between rivals four or five wide, weakened entering the lane. GO NOW angled in early to force the pace four or five wide and tired approaching the final quarter.
