Bay Colt, (Feb), by Giant's Causeway - Spunoutacontrol by Wild Again. Trainer Baffert Bob. Bred by Colts Neck Stables LLC(KY). FED BIZ had speed four wide then three deep nearing the first turn, stalked off the rail, bid alongside the runner-up leaving the second turn, took the lead into the stretch, was ridden along to inch away while lugging inward in the final furlong and was under a long hold late. CONSULADO sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, fought back leaving the second turn, came off the rail into the stretch, drifted inward in midstretch, could not match the winner but was clearly second best. BLUESKIESNRAINBOWS rank between foes early and steadied into the first turn, pulled his way along to stalk the pace inside on the backstretch, came a bit off the rail on the second turn and bested the others. TONES (IRE) settled off the rail then outside a rival, continued off the fence on the second turn and lacked a further response. SUPER CANDY saved ground off the pace, continued inside on the second turn and failed to menace.
