Supplemental nominations of \$15,000 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. \$500,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 4% to fourth 2% to fifth and 1% to sixth through ninth. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Weight: 121 lbs. This Stake will be limited to 14 starters. Preference will be given in the following manner : first preference to graded or group winners in order (I,II,III), then highest career earnings (non-restricted), then total career earnings. Different owners have equal draw according to earnings. Second choice high earners of a same owner entry receive no consideration over a single entry. Starters to be named through the entry box at usual time of closing. Failure to draw into the race will cancel all fees. **THE OWNER OF THE WINNER TO RECEIVE A TROPHY**. DAISY DEVINE raced three then two wide on the first turn, tracked the leader on the outside, made a bid midway through the far turn, edged clear under right hand urging in upper stretch, switched to a left-handed whip near the furlong marker and held sway under continued left hand urging. ST. JOHN'S RIVER was caught four wide wide on the first turn, settled towards the rear, was urged along while off the rail on the far turn, moved out then was put to a right-handed whip in upper stretch, switched to a left-handed whip near the furlong marker and closed well but missed. NIJI'S GRAND GIRL brushed with a rival at the start, moved in at the back of the field, saved ground on the first turn, settled at the rear, was urged along while two then three wide on the far turn, swung six wide at the top of the stretch, came under left hand urging near the three-sixteenths pole, drifted inward in mid-stretch and finished with good energy for the show. INGLORIOUS brushed with a rival at the start and was last away, was reserved while three wide on the first turn, moved up on the backstretch, was urged along while off the rail on the far turn, came under the whip in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick. GRANDACIOUS set the pace through moderate fractions, was challenged on the far turn, lost touch with the winner in upper stretch and weakened. TAPIT DANCER bumped with a rival at the start, was reserved towards the inside, lost position while behind a fading rival near the five-sixteenths pole, moved around that rival shortly thereafter and failed to rally. TOURMALINE raced four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while four wide on the far turn and lacked the needed response. SWITCHING GEARS bumped with a rival at the start then was in tight early, was well placed on the inside while under some restraint, came up empty on the far turn and dropped out. LITTLE MISS HOLLY was rank while three wide on the first turn, raced just off the pace while rated on the backstretch, chased three wide on the far turn, was put to the whip outside the quarter-pole, came four wide into the stretch and faded.
