right-handed whip in upper stretch, switched to a left-handed whip while chasing ADORE into the final furlong, took over outside the

sixteenth-pole then drew away under good handling. DREAM DANCE raced inside on the first turn, settled while last but one, saved ground on

the far turn, was roused at the five-sixteenths, came off the rail at the top of the stretch, dropped back to the inside at the furlong marker and just got

up for the place. ADORE raced in the two path on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, made an outside bid in the two path on the far turn,

was asked while inching clear at the quarter-pole, shied inward from the first strike of a right-handed whip outside the furlong marker, was collared by the winner outside the sixteenth-pole then weakened and was caught for the place. NORTHWEST TALE raced in the two path on the

first turn, was well placed just off the pace, chased near the rail on the far turn, moved into the two path before the five-sixteenths, shifted three wide into the stretch, had the rider lose his whip at the three-sixteenths and tired. VENUS VALENTINE raced inside on the first turn, lagged well

behind, was urged along in the two path on the far turn and failed to threaten. STAGEPLAY went three then two wide on the first turn, was reserved near the middle of the field, dropped back in the two path early on the far turn, was roused inside the three-eighths pole, came between horses at the five-sixteenths then moved to the three path, shifted four wide into the stretch and failed to rally. MIDNIGHT ON OCONEE set the pace on the

inside, lost the advantage before the five-sixteenths, dropped out at the quarter-pole and faded. STREET FANCY went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside under some urging, was hard ridden while three then four wide on the far turn and faltered.
