By subscription of \$100 due on or before December 1, 2006, with the following eligibility payments; \$100 due on or before November 1, 2007; \$250 due on or before March 1, 2008; \$350 due on or before June 1, 2008; \$500 to pass the entry box, \$750 to start. All monies to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. 5% of purses won to be awarded to the stallion nominator. 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$30,000 other than maiden or two races other than maiden or claiming allowed 2 lbs.; a race other than maiden or claiming, 4 lbs.; a race other than claiming, 6 lbs. Dark Bay or Brown Filly, (Apr), by Performing Magic - Accomplished by Awesome Again. Trainer Dutrow, Jr. E. Richard. Bred by Sugar Maple Farm(NY).

SARAH ACCOMPLISHED was patiently handled stalking the pacesetter three wide, gradually advanced towards that one after being roused in upper stretch, then prevailed during the final forty yards under a drive. MOTHER RUSSIA quickly on the lead, showed the way while racing off the inside, left the furlong grounds still holding a clear advantage, dug in when the top one made her presence, before yielding the lead during the final forty yards. SHE'S PRIME saved ground and proved to be no match for the top pair during the stretch drive. GEM FOR HOOK raced along the outside, came outward under left handed encouragement at the precise moment KISS AND FLY lugged inward under right handed encouragement, bumped twice with that rival before both were put back on a straight course, lacked the necessary stretch response during the last eighth. KISS AND FLY raced four wide around the bend, lugged inward nearing the eighth pole under right handed encouragement, bumped twice GEM FOR HOOK while that one was coming outward, got back on course, but weakened thereafter. ANJORIE was never in the hunt. SNEAKIN UP was always outrun.
