MIESQUE'S APPROVAL, unhurried early, moved out five wide on the backstretch, edged in a bit to advance between foes on the far turn, exchanged bumps with ON THE BORDER at the five-sixteenths pole, maneuvered five wide for the drive and edged clear late under urging. FREE THINKING settled in hand near the inside early, raced between foes on the backstretch, edged up nearing the lane, lacked room at the quarter-mile ground, worked his way out five wide when straightened or the drive and was up for the place. THERECOMESATIGER bobbed at the start and bumped with ON THE BORDER, forced the pace at once while slightly rank, gained the advantage before going a quarter, allowed the lead to THUNDER MISSION on the backstretch, moved outside that one four wide, recaptured the lead in the upper stretch, moved clear, but couldn't sustain the needed momentum. THUNDER MISSION bumped the side of the gate at the start, was never far back, raced four wide while a bit rank, pulled the rider to the front before going a half, made the pace into the stretch and tired. PLACE COWBOY (IRE), in hand and two wide, inched up nearing the final quarter, angled four wide for the drive but was empty. GIGAWATT, in front early, allowed the lead to THERECOMESATIGER, reached the front again between calls early on the backstretch before THUNDER MISSION took over, continued within striking distance to the stretch and tired. ON THE BORDER, bumped at the start by THERECOMESATIGER, raced five wide, exchanged bumps with the winner about the five-sixteenths pole and tired.
