CRAFTY SCHEMER , three wide, stalked the pace, gained the lead entering the stretch, opened up a clear advantage in upper stretch and gave way in the drive. GOLD CLUSTER lacked speed and rallied along the rail. CELTIC INNIS raced wide entering the stretch and failed to sustain his bid. CITY WEEKEND lacked speed, swung very wide in upper stretch and passed tired ones. ABBONDANZA , fanned wide at the head of the stretch, gave way. COUNTRY MOGGIE disputed the pace outside KAZOO and faltered. KAZOO saved ground, dueled and faltered.
