PORTE BONHEUR saved ground along the backstretch, tucked in behind the leaders on the far turn, waited for room behind horses

midway on the turn, swung four wide to get clear at the quarter pole, closed the gap in midstretch then wore down SPRITELY under steady urging in the final strides. SPRITELY raced up close between horses, moved three wide on the turn, launched a bid at the quarter pole, surged to the front opening a clear advantage in midstretch, drifted out while battling gamely into deep stretch and yielded grudgingly. TURN AWAY was outrun while trailing for a half, circled six wide while gaining at the quarter pole then closed steadily in the middle of the track but could not get up. IRON BUTTERFLY was unhurried along the backstretch, gained a bit from outside midway on the turn, swung four wide entering the stretch and lacked a strong closing response. SUNDAY GEISHA pressed the pace from outside, made a move to challenge at the three-eighths pole, battled heads apart into upper stretch and steadily tired thereafter. CAROLYN'S CAT set the pace under pressure along the rail into upper stretch and tired from her early efforts.
