Chestnut Filly, (Mar), by Grape Tree Road (GB) - Exciting Times (FR) by Jeune Homme. Trainer Biancone L. Patrick. Bred by E.A.R.L. Elevage De La Source(FR).

GORELLA (FR), reserved early two or three wide, began to advance nearing the end of the backstretch, came out from between horses four or five wide leaving the second turn, engaged leaders at the furlong grounds, gained a slight edge about the sixteenth pole and proved gamely best under left-handed urging. KAREN'S CAPER, never far back and four wide, came a bit wider when rallying into the stretch, reached the front approaching the final furlong, was joined from the inside by GORELLA (FR) soon after and was outfinished. MY TYPHOON (IRE), well placed under light restraint early while stalking the dueling leaders two or three wide, made a bold run to reach the front a quarter-mile out, held on well until the furlong grounds and weakened. DASH OF HUMOR broke in the air, settled three or four wide, edged up between foes approaching the stretch, angled five wide for the drive and improved position. MEA DOMINA went up early to press front-running STELLA BLUE (FR) three or four wide, reached the front for a couple of strides approaching the final quarter, was headed entering the lane by MY TYPHOON (IRE) from the outside and weakened CHIC DANCER raced within striking distance four wide for six furlongs and came up empty. WEND was backed into the starting gate. During the running, WEND followed the pace five wide, was asked for more three furlongs out and couldn't respond. STELLA BLUE (FR) gained the advantage early while racing near the inside, showed the way two wide on the backstretch, was headed approaching the final quarter from the outside by MEA DOMINA and weakened thereafter.
