TAPITSFLY settled in hand, ranged into striking distance four wide, tipped out six wide entering the stretch, poked her head in front with a furlong to run and proved best following a prolonged drive. DAISY DEVINE prompted the pace three deep, joined the vanguard three wide near the quarter pole, dug in to meet the challenge of TAPITSFLY but grudgingly gave in late. HUNGRY ISLAND was off a bit slow and unhurried into stride, moved up four wide through the turn, shifted out further entering the stretch but was unable to bridge the gap. SUMMER SOIREE opened clear to set the pace off of the inside, was collared between horses leaving the second turn and gave way readily once headed. BRILLIANT FUTURE was rank to place through the first turn, leveled into stride and tucked in to save ground, got through to make a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. SNOW FALL was unhurried along the inside and was never a factor.
