Any horse that has won a graded stake or has participated in a race at Gulfstream Park will be charged no additional fees to enter and start. Any horse that has finished second, third, or fourth in a graded stake shall pay a fee of \$2,500 to enter and start. All other horses shall pay a fee of \$5,000 to enter and start. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: 122 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Supplemental nominations may be made at time of entry for a fee of \$1,500, which does not include the entry or starting fees as stated above. All fees shall be paid prior to the start of the race. All horses that are nominated or supplemented to the Xpressbet Florida Derby may be subject to out of competition testing prior to the running of the race. If more than 14 horses are entered, preference will be given to graded stakes winners, then by highest career earnings. (Clear 84)

ALWAYS DREAMING steadied between rivals in the first turn, settled in outside position stalking the leader, sat comfortable then began to inch way up closer to the lead turning for home, roused four wide to kick by and gain command, angled in couple paths under right handed encouragement, then pulled away to clear lead with amount of victory determined by the rider. STATE OF HONOR pulled then steadied in first turn, settled in shortly after and stalked near inside throughout the backstretch, sat patiently couple paths off inside in far turn, took advantage of rail opening up, angled inside to gain edge, moved up near the lead, was no match for eventual winner but continued a solid effort for runner up spot. GUNNEVERA quickly angled to rail from outside position after the start, moved off inside in early backstretch and continued near the back, began to rouse for response leaving the backstretch, remained bit sluggish while urging past the three eighths pole, hustled up six wide entering the lane, steadily moved up closer and gained show. IMPRESSIVE EDGE was nicely rated in range from outside position, began to pick up pace past the half mile marker, came under hand ride in far turn then was set down driving four then three wide in the lane, was not match for winner but dug in for runner up spot then evened out holding a small piece of the action, THREE RULES sped to clear lead at the start, continued to set the pace by comfortable margin, held firm on top at five sixteenths pole, felt rivals closing in at the guarter pole, lost lead to eventual winner top stretch, kept along for runner up spots then flattened in late drive. TALK LOGISTICS raced off the early pace, hustled up for response along the outside, altered course mid-stretch and failed to produce needed rally for impact. COLEMAN ROCKY raced off the pace in the backstretch, roused three wide in far turn, angled out widest of all in lane, made up mild amount of ground. UNBRIDLED HOLIDAY raced near then in the back and failed to move into range. CHARLIE THE GREEK raced midpack just off inside in early stages, could not sustain bid in far turn then dropped back. QUINIENTOS raced in range in early stages, lost action midway through the backstretch and had no late response.
