COTTON BLOSSOM stalked the early leaders, bid three wide after six furlongs, gained the lead into the stretch then slowly edged away under steady handling. SUAVENESS made a middle move through the second turn, followed the winner's path to mid stretch then came out late while getting up for the place. MARIA'S KITTY fanned six wide then was slowly making up some ground along the far outside late. AUTOBAHN GIRL looped five wide through the second turn to be in striking distance into the stretch but weakened in the drive then was steadied over the heels of SUAVENESS when that one came out late. DESIRE TO EXCEL vied for the lead from the outset to the stretch, held on well to the final furlong then weakened. TRAINEE failed to threaten. SAINT BARBARA set a solid pace for more than five furlongs then came up empty. DINNER BREAK stopped.
