DISCO PARTNER tracked the pace along the inside coming under coaxing five-sixteenths from home, angled three wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command a furlong from home and drew clear under a drive shying from the stick through to the finish. GET JETS saved ground near the rear, came under coaxing seven-sixteenths from home and angled out three wide briefly three furlongs from home, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, kicked on belatedly to secure the place honors in the final jumps. BONDURANT rated just off the inside in mid pack, came under coaxing three furlongs out, angled four wide at the head of the stretch, offered up a mild kick to procure the show honors. KING KREESA established the front and showed the way in hand along the inside under prompting from CERISE'S PRINCE to the outside, remained patiently handled through moderate splits awaiting a challenge in earnest through the far turn, cut the corner roused into upper stretch, shook off his prompter straightened away for home confronted by the eventual winner, got headed a furlong out, weakened in the late going. OFFERING PLAN just off the inside at the tail of the field in reserve, came under coaxing angled four wide midway on the turn, spun two to three wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild bid but was outkicked in the drive. CERISE'S PRINCE promoted the pace of KING KREESA while three to four wide in hand down the backstretch, tucked to the two path half a mile from home, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, spun just off the inside for home, weakened in the stretch. GRAND ARCH just off the inside in mid pack in the clear, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, angled three wide into upper stretch, weakened in the stretch.
