Non-winners of a Grade 1 in 2006 allowed 2 lbs.; a Grade 1 in 2005; or a Grade 2 in 2006, 4 lbs.; a Graded Sweepstake in 2006, 6 lbs. POMEROY flashed good speed from the start, argued the pace while between rivals in hand, dug in resolutely when set down turning for home and drew clear late under a drive. WAR FRONT bumped with SILVER WAGON at the start, raced with the pace while three wide, could not get past the winner when asked for run and held the place while weakening in deep stretch. FRIENDLY ISLAND was outrun early, advanced inside on the turn, angled out in the stretch and finished well outside. SILVER WAGON broke awkwardly, bumped with WAR FRONT, dropped back early, raced inside, rallied into the stretch and finished well on the rail. MASS MEDIA was hustled along outside, was caught four wide on the turn and lacked a serious rally. NIGHTMARE AFFAIR was hustled along early, put in a three wide run on the turn and had nothing left for the stretch drive. AWESOME TWIST was outrun early, raced inside, rallied in upper stretch and was going well late. JUDITHS WILD RUSH broke running, showed good speed while between rivals, chased the pace into the stretch and tired. GREELEY'S GALAXY was outrun early, came wide into the stretch and had no response when roused. COMMENTATOR broke awkwardly, was hustled up on the rail, chased the pace along the inside and was finished after the opening half mile. SPANISH CHESTNUT was hustled up inside, contested the pace along the rail and tired entering the stretch.
