By subscription of \$250 each, which should accompany the nomination; \$1,250 to pass the entry box, \$1,250 to start. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. Three year olds, 120 lbs.; Older 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade 1 in 2008 allowed 2 lbs.; a Grade 1 in 2007; or a Grade 2 in 2008, 4 lbs.; a Graded Sweepstake in 2008, 6 lbs. FIRST DEFENCE rushed up along the rail, battled heads apart to the far turn, surged to the front at the three-eighths pole, shook loose in upper stretch, opened a comfortable advantage in midstretch and drew away under steady urging. GREELEY'S CONQUEST was bumped at the start, chased the leaders from outside along the backstretch, lodged a bid four wide leaving the turn then finished willingly from outside to narrowly gain the place. FEROCIOUS FIRES stumbled at the start, moved up along the rail, saved ground on the turn then closed late along the inside to gain a share. ETERNAL STAR dueled outside the winner to the top of the stretch and weakened from his early efforts.

TASTEYVILLE raced well back between horses for five furlongs and rallied mildly. LUCKY ISLAND (ARG) stumbled then took up after being pinched back at the start, was outrun early, made a strong move five wide leaving the turn then flattened out in the stretch. PREMIUM WINE raced in midpack for a half and steadily tired thereafter. BOLD START stalked three wide for five furlongs and tired. FOREFATHERS failed to mount a serious rally while six wide on the turn. REAL ESTATE stumbled after being pinched back at the start, took up and angled to the rail, saved ground to the turn and faltered in the stretch. There was a Stewards' inquiry focusing on the start of the race before the result was declared official.
