7 FURLONGS. (1:20) STAKES. Purse \$150,000 Forward Gal S. (Grade III) FILLIES, THREE YEARS OLD. Free nomination by Sunday, January 20. \$1,500 to enter. \$150,000 Guaranteed. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, and 3% to fifth. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of a graded stakes allowed 2 lbs.; a stakes race, 4 lbs.; two races other than maiden, claiming, or starter, 6 lbs. Starters to be named by usual time of closing. Supplemental nominations may be made at time of entry. All fees shall be paid prior to the start of the race. This race will be limited to 14 starters, with also eligibles. Preference will be given to graded stakes winners, then by highest career earnings. Trophy to the winning owner. (Cloudy 78)

FEEDBACK settled nicely in opening stages and raced in tracking position behind FASHION FAUX PAS, inherited the lead near seven sixteenths pole then came under pressure from BYE BYE J, continued to hold on top still unleashed mid-way through the turn, came under strong left handed drive upper stretch and had more in reserve, still under strong pressure from determined BYE BYE J but refused to relinquish control and continued to hold off foes in gritty performance. BYE BYE J raced in range being rated in early stages, edged up closer when FEEDBACK took the lead entering far turn, moved up to apply pressure then kept after rival determinedly, never gave up just could not gain equal terms with tenacious winner and held late for place. CHAMPAGNE ANYONE was allowed to settle out of the gate and saved ground along inside, picked up pace and gained closer contention upon entering the far turn, switched out couple paths and hustled up into stretch, came under right handed urging and roused forward near inside, raced in striking range deep stretch, could get to game winner then edged out for place. JELTRIN was rated off the early leaders positioned three to four wide, commenced steady four wide bid in far turn, kept under a ride into stretch, came out wider under left handed urging and raced in contention then lacked late needed kick to impact leaders. HOROLOGIST raced off the early pace, came under a ride going through the turn, set down five wide for the drive but was not enough for impact. HOLLYWOOD GLORY raced in the back along the outside, dropped to inside late backstretch then switched back out and came under a ride but failed to kick on. BRUNETTE PRINCESS raced in tracking position through the backstretch, continued close bid at three eighths pole then failed to keep pace and began to fade. FROND hustled up along outside, showed early interest then failed to sustain bid and dropped back. FASHION FAUX PAS led the way through early stages then lost top spot to winner then retreated.
