PROMISES FULFILLED broke sharp and sped to lead at the start, cleared on top and angled inside, set the pace saving ground while firmly rated in early stages then settled nicely on top, was confidently handled still unasked with rivals edging closer near three eighths pole, tapped past the quarter then put to drive two wide entering the lane, responded and held length on top over STRIKE POWER, found more in reserve and kicked clear. STRIKE POWER broke well then stalked two to three wide in early stages, hustled up past the half mile marker, was poised to strike at the quarter pole, continued in striking distance of PROMISES FULFILLED, but lacked needed kick to reach game foe and settled for second best. GOOD MAGIC was rated under snug hold racing five wide in early stages, inched up closer three wide past the half mile marker, raced in close contention running through far turn, could not kick on with top pair entering the lane, kept of five wide and secured share. MACHISMO was taken off early pace, made three wide run in final turn far turn, continued with response driving two wide upper stretch, gained position without threatening late leaders. MARCONI was step slow and bit awkward at the start, continued reserved racing widest through the backstretch, hustled up along outside and continued wide entering the lane then passed tiring rivals. GOTTA GO raced in range between rivals midway through the backstretch then began steady retreat in the far turn. STORM RUNNER secured rail position in first turn then raced just off leader and steadied while in tight along rail in opening quarter, continued to track up close along the inside then lost action moving through far turn. HE TAKES CHARGE saved ground racing off the pace, hustled up along the rail and briefly gained closer position before coming up empty three furlongs out, PEPPERED raced near the back then hustled up upon entering backstretch to race mid-range midway through the backstretch then came up empty after the half.
