Purse \$150,000 *FOURSTARDAVE H.(GRADE II) INNER TURF A HANDICAP FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD.* By subscription of \$150 each, which should accompany the nomination; \$750 to pass the entry box and \$750 to start. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. DIRT Weights: Three year olds, 121 lbs.; Older 126 lbs. Non-winners of a Graded Sweepstake on the dirt in 2005-06 allowed 2 lbs.; A sweepstake on the dirt in 2005-06, 4 lbs.; four races on the dirt, 6 lbs.; three races on the dirt, 8 lbs. (Maiden, claiming and starter races not considered). A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. In the event this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Closed Saturday, July 22, 2006 with 27 nominations.

REMARKABLE NEWS (VEN) sprinted clear in the early stages, raced uncontested on the front while saving ground for six furlongs, extended his lead in upper stretch, drifted out in midstretch and edged away under steady right hand urging. ASHKAL WAY (IRE) was taken in hand early, raced just behind the leaders along the backstretch, swung out to launch his bid on the far turn, circled four wide entering the stretch, gained a bit in upper stretch but was no match for the winner while clearly best of the others. DIAMOND GREEN (FR) raced in close contention along the inside, saved ground to the turn, angled between horses entering the stretch and lacked a strong closing response. ARTIE SCHILLER settled just off the early pace, stalked the leaders in the two path for six furlongs, edged closer between horses on the turn, checked and altered course between horses in upper stretch and weakened in the final eighth. NOBLE CAUSEWAY was eased back in the early stages then trailed throughout.
