1 MILE. (Inner Turf) (1.33²) STAKES. Purse \$500,000 *FOURSTARDAVE H. (GRADE II) INNER TURF A HANDICAP FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD.* By subscription of \$500 each which should accompany the nomination; \$3,500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$4,000 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$5,000 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the publication of weights. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. Di rt weights to be assigned as follows: Three year olds, 121 lbs.; Older 126 lbs. Non-winners of a Graded Sweepstake on the dirt in 2013-14 allowed 2 lbs.; A sweepstake on the dirt in 2013-14, 4 lbs.; four races on the dirt, 6 lbs. (Maiden, claiming, and re stricted allowance races not considered in allowances). A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track where dirt allowance weights will apply. In the event thatt his race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Closed Saturday, July 26, 2014 with 14 Nominations. (Rail at 18 feet). SEEK AGAIN saved ground on the first turn, settled a bit off the inside on the backstretch, moved closer under urging while along the rail on the far turn, came off the inside into the stretch, waited while blocked shortly thereafter, dropped to the inside to take the vacated spot of SILVER MAX as that rival tired, had that opening taken away when SAYAAD drifted in approaching the eighth-pole, steadied while blocked again, found room when the aforementioned rival left the inside again shortly thereafter, rallied along the rail under a strong hand ride, took the lead inside the sixteenth-pole and prevailed while clearly best. GRAND ARCH came away in good order, raced in the two path on the first turn, settled in third position, was coaxed along near the half-mile pole, went two then three wide on the far turn, advanced under a drive into the stretch, made a bid under a left-handed whip then gained a short lead, drifted in some after being switched to a right-handed near the sixteenth-pole and was denied. JACK MILTON saved ground on the first turn, was unhurried towards the rear, came under urging while inside on the far turn, shifted off the rail in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths, was driven three wide into the stretch, chased under a left-handed whip, raced behind GRAND ARCH into the final furlong, found open space near the sixteenth-pole and finished with good courage to garner the show. DORSETT raced off the rail on the first turn, settled on the outside while under some coaxing, was urged along while two then three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch, chased under a right-handed whip and finished willingly but was outkicked. SAYAAD tracked the pace on the outside, inched closer with a half-mile to run, drew alongside SILVER MAX on the far turn, took the lead near the quarter-pole, drifted in some under a right-handed whip in upper stretch, took the rail away from the winner, came back out when switched to a left-handed whip inside the furlong marker, was in tight between horses at the sixteenth-pole and weakened late. SILVER MAX was away alertly, went straight to the front, set the pace on the inside through solid fractions, was urged along when challenged on the far turn, dropped out turning into the stretch and tired. (Rail at 18 Feet)
