1 MILE. (Inner Turf) (1:34) STAKES. Purse \$500,000 Fourstardave H INNER TURF A HANDICAP FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$500 each which should accompany the nomination; \$3,500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$4,000 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$5,000 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the publication of weights. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. Dirt weights to be assigned as follows: Three year olds, 121 lbs.; Older 126 lbs. Non-winners of a Graded Sweepstake on the dirt in 2014-15 allowed 2 lbs.; of a sweepstake on the dirt in 2014-15, 4 lbs.; of four races on the dirt, 6 lbs. (Maiden, claiming, and state-bred allowance races not considered in allowances). A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track where dirt allowance weights will apply. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Closed Saturday August 1, 2015 with 30 Nominations. (Rail at 18 feet). Bay Gelding, (Feb), by Arch - Bacinella by El Gran Senor. Trainer Brian A. Lynch. Bred by Hunter Valley Farm & S. Hillen (KY).

GRAND ARCH rated tracking the pace from the pocket, angled to the two path nearing the quarter pole and swung just off the inside at that station, rallied to take command narrowly a furlong from home, tussled with KING KREESEA through to the sixteenth pole before shaking that foe off some, came under threat from a trio and dug in to hold on and prevail. IRONICUS saved ground at the rear in reserve early on, tipped out three wide three furlongs from home coming under light coaxing, angled six wide into upper stretch, offered up a good finish down the center of the course the outermost of a quintet battling to the wire and was ultimately rebuffed on the line. SEEK AGAIN bobbed slightly at the start recovering outwards and bumping lightly with GRAND TITO, raced just off the inside near the rear in between foes and off heels steadying briefly with seven and a half furlongs to go, saved ground near the rear, came under coaxing five-sixteenths from home, cut the corner into upper stretch, angled to the two path three-sixteenths out and rallied to issue a challenge through the final sixteenth, dug in surging late between foes, the rider's off sided rein action coming very close to striking MSHAWISH while intimidating that foe to the wire in the last jumps and just got the show honors in the last strides. KING KREESEA away well, established the front and showed the way in hand along the inside, cut sensible fractions to midway on the far turn coming under light coaxing as the pressure in behind intensified, cut the corner roused into upper stretch under threat, dug in and was headed a furlong from home, fought on the innermost of a quintet battling it out to the wire and just preserve the last major share on the wire. MSHAWISH saved ground in mid pack in reserve, came under coaxing midway on the far turn, angled three to four wide into upper stretch set down for the drive, rallied stacked four wide through the stretch in a bit tight between foes late and under intimidation from the inside and was outfinished in the last jumps. JACK MILTON brushed the near side stall at the start, settled three wide in mid pack under rating, came under urging three furlongs from home, spun four to five wide into upper stretch and made no headway. GRAND TITO bumped at the start by SEEK AGAIN who recovered outwards after bobbling at the start, raced just off the pace just off the inside, came under coaxing five-sixteenths from home, spun just off the inside into upper stretch and tired. SKYRING attended the pace from the two path coming under prolonged coaxing from the seven-sixteenths, swung three wide for home and faltered in the drive.
