RING WEEKEND to steady their mounts, secured a prominent position, was two wide entering the clubhouse turn, got sent over towards the inside after halfway around it, picking up the benefit of KING KREESA's cover, began to inch his way back into the two path midway down the

backstretch, crept up to take on the previously-named rival after stepping onto the far turn, stumbled taking a bad step a few jumps shy of the quarter pole, led the field by a narrow margin spinning into the stretch, was deep into the furlong grounds before switched over to stronger handling, dug in with good determination to fend off the runner up. A LOT bumped soundly into by the winner after bobbling at the break, was taken in hand then cut over sharply to the inside route, stayed put for six furlongs, was placed on the receiving of some brisk hand encouragement at the five-sixteenths pole, got set down angling to the outside heading home, kicked into his best strde, split rivals in midstretch, gained ground in a

willing manner en route for the place. GRAND ARCH took up the chase from the two path on each bend, was put to a drive at the five-sixteenths pole, came three wide into the strech and was outfinished. KING KREESA out-broke the competition and kept the advantage, was pulling rankly on the bit nearng the end of the homestretch, carved out the pace from along the inside route, with the top one in the general vicinity, had that one range up to challenge after leaving the backstretch, was let out a notch in response to it, fell back by a sliver by the end of the second bend, settled into upper stretch before having the rder resort to a drive, weakened into the show slot. FORCE THE PASS underwent a two wide trip for three-quarters pole, was driven four wide into upper stretch, had no response. RING WEEKEND steadied getting pinched shortly after the start, faltered off the ground-saving journey that followed.
