(Grade I) INNER TURF A HANDICAP FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$500 each which should accompany the nomination; \$3,500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$4,000 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$5,000 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the publication of weights. The purse to be divided 55% to the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth, 4% to fifth and 3% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Closed Saturday, July 28, 2018 with 21 Nominations. (Rail at 18 feet). Chestnut Colt, (Apr), by English Channel - Mystic Chant by Unbridled's Song. Trainer Linda Rice. Bred by Stonewall Farm (NY).

VOODOO SONG came away in good order, showed good speed on the outside, moved clear approaching the first turn, raced inside on that bend, drew off to a sizable advantage, was asked while seeing his lead diminish while along the rail on the far turn, responded well when put to a right-handed whip in upper stretch, drifted out a couple of paths near the furlong marker while switched to a left-handed whip, braced for the challenge of DELTA PRINCE, went back to a right-handed whip at the sixteenth-pole, dug in very gamely to the wire and held off the runner-up under strong handling. DELTA PRINCE brushed the outside of the gate at the start, saved ground on the first turn, settled towards the rear of the field, moved closer while roused in the four path on the far turn, brushed with MADE YOU LOOK inside the three-sixteenths, was put to a right-handed whip coming to the furlong marker, closed well to draw alongside the winner into the final sixteenth, fought determinedly to the wire but was turned away by the resolute winner and denied but was clear for the place. DIVISIDERO dropped back on the initial straightaway, went around the first turn in the two to three path, settled at the back on the outside, moved closer while roused in the five path on the far turn, came under a right-handed whip in upper stretch, held a good striking position into the final furlong but was out-kicked then finished willingly for the show. MADE YOU LOOK was taken back off the pace on the run into the first turn, rounded that bend in the two path, settled in third position, advanced closer while asked in the three path on the far turn, loomed the first danger to the winner turning into the stretch, remained on his inside lead past the three-sixteenths, brushed with DELTA PRINCE shortly thereafter and swapped to the proper lead, chased into the final furlong and weakened. YOSHIDA (JPN) broke out at the start and was last to commence, traveled around the first turn in the three path, settled on the outside, moved in near the five-eighths pole, saved ground on the far turn, was roused at the five-sixteenths then shifted to the two path, spun three wide into the stretch, was asked for his best around the three-sixteenths and lacked the needed response. HEART TO HEART was moving around at the start and broke awkwardly but with the field, showed early speed then dropped behind the very quick VOODOO SONG, raced inside to the two path on the first turn, followed the aforementioned rival from afar down the backstretch, moved closer under urging in the two path on the far turn, dropped back into upper stretch and had nothing left. (Rail at 18 Feet)
