GENERAL A ROD dueled for the lead three wide outside WILDCAT RED throughout and just missed. TOP BILLING outrun early, split rivals on the far turn while advancing into contention, swung out for the stretch run and rallied for the show while unable to get to the top ones. EAST HALL unhurried early, saved ground around the far turn and passed tired rivals without threatening. MEDAL COUNT tracked the leaders three wide to nearing the stretch, then gave way. COMMISSIONER well placed racing off the rail, tired leaving the far turn. OUR CARAVAN raced four wide and faltered. WE MISS ARTIE reserved early, made a run to reach contention on the far turn, then faded in the drive. BEST PLAN YET was through after six furlongs. C. ZEE tracked the leaders three wide into the far turn and had nothing left. ALMOST FAMOUS steadied soon after the start, then was no factor while racing four wide. HESINFRONT was done early.
