QARAABA (GB) a bit slow to begin, pulled inside then just off the rail, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch, rallied under good handling to gain the lead outside foes in deep stretch and proved best. TIZ FLIRTATIOUS tugged her way along three deep then stalked outside a rival, went three wide into and on the second turn and four wide into the stretch, bid outside foes past the eighth pole then three wide and continued willingly but could not quite match the winner late. MORE CHOCOLATE stalked outside a rival then off the rail, bid alongside the pacesetter leaving the backstretch and between foes on the second turn and in the stretch, put a head in front in midstretch, fought back in deep stretch and held third. HALO DOLLY pulled inside then split horses on the backstretch, bid three deep into and on the second turn and in the stretch, was between horses in deep stretch and was outfinished. I DAZZLE also pulled early, chased a bit off the rail then inside on the backstretch and second turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. CAMELIA ROSE (FR) saved ground stalking the pace, cut the corner into the stretch, waited off heels in midstretch, came out a bit, went around a rival in deep stretch but could not summon the necessary late response. IMPERIALISTIC DIVA (IRE) bobbed at the start, had speed between horses then outside a rival, angled in and set the pace inside, dueled into and on the second turn, fought back along the rail in the stretch and weakened late. HARD TO RESIST stalked between horses then outside a rival on the backstretch, continued between foes on the second turn and lacked the needed rally in the lane. VIVO PER LEI chased three deep then alongside a foe, continued three wide into and on the second turn and five wide into the stretch and had little left for the drive.
