Dark Bay or Brown Colt, (Feb), by Broad Brush - Salty Gal by Cox's Ridge. Trainer Zito P. Nicholas. Bred by Live Oak Stud(KY). HESANOLDSALT was well place in the early going, took charge when asked for run at the three-eighths pole, dug in when threaten in upper stretch then edged clear under strong right hand encouragement. REHOBOTH was unhurried for a half, gained steadily while three wide on the turn, made a run to threaten at the quarter pole but was no match for the winner. DRY MARTINI raced in midpack, gained while four wide to reach contention on the turn, lodged a strong bid at the quarter pole and flattened out. BIG LOVER was unhurried for six furlongs, raced evenly on the turn and failed to threaten while improving his position. DAZZLING DR. CEVIN raced in good position along the rail throughout, checked briefly in upper stretch and lacked a late response. SIR JACKIE steadied along the inside nearing the first turn and failed to threaten thereafter. SUPERVISOR angled out while well back on the turn and lacked a rally. B. B. BEST chased the leaders for seven furlongs and tired. WE CAN SEEK (CHI) saved ground and tired. ITSAWONDERFULIFE was never a factor. SIPHON CITY was used up setting the early pace.
