TOMMY MACHO stalked outside from the start, took over three wide with a quarter-mile remaining, shifted to the two-path edging away under a full drive to upper stretch, and withstood a prolonged challenge from CONQUEST BIG E to prevail. CONQUEST BIG E hopped at the break, then steadied slightly off the heels of FRAMMENTO a stride or two later, ranged up with a four-wide run late on the turn, tested TOMMY MACHO through a long drive and was second best. TALE OF SILENCE saved ground to the turn, shifted two then three wide turning for home, and ran on evenly with daylight on the rest. GIUSEPPE THE GREAT was outsprinted early, swung four wide late on the turn, and improved position without threatening. FRAMMENTO trailed inside to the stretch, came off the rail for the drive and passed tired horses. FIRST GROWTH pressed the pace outside MOVES LIKE ALI, gained a brief lead between horses with three-eighths to run, but could not keep pace turning for home. BEASLEY raced three to four wide and showed little. EIGHT TOWN had little maneuvering room behind and between horses up the backstretch, got clearance three wide around the turn, but came up empty. MOVES LIKE ALI stumbled at the start, sped off to the early lead, gave way soon after going five furlongs, and was not persevered with in the lane.
