A Z WARRIOR patiently tracked the pacesetter from the three path, ranged up when ready to issue a challenge for the lead coming to the three-eighths pole, went by, with the rider still keeping something in reserve, spurted away from the competition once asked for run in upper stretch, then held sway while being hand urged to the finish line. R HEAT LIGHTNING broke awkwardly, then required the rider to grab hold after veering in sharply, got expertly put back on a truer course soon afterwards, stubbornly resisted the rating tactics being applied by the rider, viciously fighting against the bit throughout the initial half mile, continued along the inside during the run around the second bend, was forced to be kept on hold, briefly boxed in as the field neared the quarter pole, found room to maneuver off the inside shortly after entering the stretch, responded well once called upon, closed with good energy during the final furlong, cutting into the leader's margin en route for place honors. JOYFUL VICTORY strung out four wide at the half mile pole, sat reserved until the quarter pole before making a bid, failed to keep pace with the top one after turning for home, but held well enough to the wire to take the show. VALIANT PASSION broke on top, but was taken to the back of the pack, entered the turn from the three path, still well reserved, advanced into contention, angled four wide into the stretch, but had no serious stretch offering. TAP FOR LUCK took the inside route, slipped outward at the three-eighths pole and rallied mildly to improve position. COAX LIBERTY set the early fractions while being rated in the two path, offered briefly resistance when tested by the top one at the three-eighths, readily succumbed and steadily tired thereafter. MAPLE FOREST was through after completing three-quarters. AFTER LATER urged on the turn, tired.
