BY THE MOON tracked the pace two to three wide in closest range of the front, took over nearing the quarter pole, got roused cornering three wide into upper stretch, edged away under a drive to the eighth pole, held safe kept to task to the wire. WONDER GAL broke in at the start bumping CAVORTING, chased inside under light coaxing before being put to a drive three furlongs from home, angled three wide into the stretch, offered up a mild kick through the final eighth to secure the place honors. FEATHERED urged along from the get go in pursuit two to three wide just off the pace, spun four wide at the quarter pole, rallied into contention through the final sixteenth offering up a mild kick to procure the show honors. CONDO COMMANDO chased three to four wide, commenced prolonged encouragement a half mile from home coming under the whip midway on the turn, made mild progress into upper stretch continuing four wide at that juncture, drifted out despite an off sided stick through the stretch three to four paths and made no late headway. CAYMAN CROC coaxed along chasing the front four to five wide from towards the rear, got put to a drive at the seven-sixteenths continuing in the overland route through the turn, swung six to seven wide into upper stretch, improved mildly by tired foes in deep stretch. RING KNOCKER broke in at the start, raced two to three wide towards the rear, came under a ride midway on the turn, angled five wide into upper stretch, made no impact. CAVORTING bumped at the start by WONDER GAL who broke inwards, came under coaxing and cut a solid pace just off the inside in hand until the five-sixteenths, got spirited up at that station under challenge from the eventual winner, yielded the lead nearing the quarter pole and spun just off the inside into the lane, then faltered in the drive.
