Purse \$300,000 Florida Sire Affirmed S.COLTS AND GELDINGS, TWO YEARS OLD, THAT ARE FLORIDA SIRE STAKES NOMINATED. \$2,000 to pass the entry box and \$1,000 additional to start, with a purse of \$300,000. 60% of the purse to be distributed to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth, 3% to fifth. All starters will receive a \$1,500 rebate. Weight: 118 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. All fees shall be paid prior to the start of the race. This race will be limited to 14 starters, with also eligibles. If more than 14 entries pass the entry box preference will be given to horses with highest career earnings. Trophy to the Winning Owner. Nominations closed Thursday, January 15, 2015. (Cloudy 88)

TRIBAL DRAMA tracked top two leaders in the backstretch, edged up closer three furlongs out, challenged DREA OF ME at quarter pole, dueled gamely along outside, had slight lead nearing the wire and prevailed under driving finish. ABERCORN stalked pace racing between rivals in early stages, picked up pace leaving the backstretch, moved up off top two, hustled up for drive, gained ground willingly along outside, was getting to TRIBAL DRAMA in final strides and just missed. L'L MEATBALL was bumped at the start, settled in along rail, bumped a bit at the half, angled off inside, moved between rivals at five sixteenths pole, raced within contention, dug in gamely, produced late kick and up for show. DREAM OF ME slightly hopped and brushed at start, raced on top by narrow margins in backstretch, challenged running into far turn, dueled along inside of eventual winner, continued bid into late drive and flattened out in final sixteenth. DANBURY broke out and brushed at start, was unhurried racing off top two flights, continued save ground along inside, moved up into contention in upper stretch, failed to sustain bid and weakened in late drive. BRIGHTON LANE broke in and brushed at start, was unhurried and raced near back, urged for response just off inside in stretch and lacked needed kick. FELLOWSHIP was well reserved racing in or near the back of pack, hustled up along outside in far turn, dug in six wide in stretch, made up some ground but needed more to impact leaders. NO MORE CHILLIN settled back off pace in the backstretch, hustled up running in far turn, dug in between at quarter pole, could not sustain bid and gawey. NIGHT RYTHM was reserved in early satges and raced near the back, urged for response along outside in far turn and failed to kick on. SWAGGER JAGGER was unhurried in the backstretch, urged for response running around far turn, failed to respond and weakened. BIGGEST DRAMA was bumped at start, raced near the back and never moved into contention. MR. KISSES was bumped between at the start, raced in contention in early stages, gawey after half, dropped back and had no response in lane.
