FOR TWO YEAR OLDS.** By subscription of \$2,500 each (Stallion) ; \$3,500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$3,500 to start . The added money together with all nomination fees, eligibility payments, entry and starting fees to be divided - Approximatel y 66.5% of gross purse after distribution of Stallion Nominator and Breeders' Awards. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to thir d, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Stallion and Breeders' Awards to be distributed according to Florida Statute in effect on the date of the race. Weight: 118 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning Owner, Trainer, and Jockey. Nominations for Stallio ns closed on February 15, 2007 with 124 Stallion Nominations. (No Supplementary Nominations). Closed July 14, 2010 with 634 nominations. (Clear 85)
