1 $\frac{1}{4}$  MILES. (1.422) STAKES. Purse \$300,000 *FLORIDA STALLION MY DEAR GIRL S. FOR FILLIES, TWO YEAR OLDS*. By subscription of \$2,500 each (Stallion); \$2,500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$2,500 to start. The added money together with all nomination fees, eligibility payments, entry and starting fees to be divided. Approximate 66.5% of gross purse October 13 after distribution of Stallion Nominator and Breeders' Awards. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Stallion and Breeders' Awards to be distributed according to Florida Statute in effect on the date of the race. Weight: 118 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning Owner. Nominations for Stallions closed on February 15, 2009 with 107 Stallion Nominations. (No Supplementary Nominations). Closed Friday, May 18, 2012 with 408 nominations. (Clear 78)

VERSO A VERSO stalked the pace along the inside, eased outside the leaders leaving the far turn, rallied to take over in early stretch, then drew away under urging. ASHLEE'S PRINCESS outrun early, eased out for room on the far turn and rallied to prove best of the rest while unable to match strides with the winner. SO BLESSED rated off the pace, raced three wide around the far turn and passed tired rivals for the show while unable to keep pace with the top ones. PUTITINMYPOCKET was tracking the pace off the rail when steadied from between rivals on the far turn and tired. CAPRICCIO BLUE was not a factor. PUTYOURDREAMSAWAY reserved off the pace after hitting the gate at the start, advanced down the backstretch to reach contention, stalked the leaders to the top of the stretch, then faltered. JEWEL IN THE SKY sprinted to a clear lead off the rail, eased to the inside when challenged by CANDY CODED KISSES on the backstretch, maintained a slim advantage into the far turn, then had nothing left. CANDY CODED KISSES chased the pace, moved up to engage JEWEL IN THE SKY racing down the backstretch, gained a slim advantage midway of the far turn, made the pace into the stretch, then faded. NASTY CAT was through after six furlongs and eased in the stretch run.
