1 1/4 MILES. (Turf) (1.38) STAKES. Purse \$100,000 FT. LAUDERDALE S. (GRADE III) FOR FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. Free nomination by Saturday December 31, 2011, \$1,000 to pass the entry box and \$500 additional to start, with \$100,000 Guaranteed. All fees shall be paid prior to the start of the race. The owner of the winner to receive \$6 0,000, \$20,000 to second, \$10,000 to third, \$5,000 to fourth, \$3,000 to fifth and \$2,000 to sixth. Supplemental nominations may be made at time of entry for a fee of \$5,000, which includes entry and starting fees. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a grade I or II stakes on the turf in 2011 allowed 2 lbs.; of a sweepstakes at a mile or over on the turf since July 1, 4lbs., \$45,000 at a mile or over since August 1, 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. This race will be limited to 14 Starters, with Also Eligibles. If more than fourteen (14) entries pass the entry box preference will be given to graded stakes winners, then highest 2010-2012 earnings. Trophy to the winning owner. Nominations Closed on Saturday, December 31, 2011 with 38 Nominations. (If deemed inadvisable to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile and One Sixteenth). (Cloudy 60)

Bay Colt, (May), by Badge of Silver - Another Vegetarian by Stalwart. Trainer Pletcher A. Todd. Bred by Brereton C. Jones(KY). SILVER MEDALLION allowed to settle, circled rivals five wide around the far turn to reach contention, then was bumped by MUTUAL TRUST while rallying to gain the lead at the sixteenth pole and prevailed. YUMMY WITH BUTTER set the pace along the rail into the stretch, then came out under left-handed pressure knocking MUTUAL TRUST into SILVER MEDALLION, responded when headed by the latter at the sixteenth pole and held on well while being edged to the wire. HOLLINGER taken in hand early, raced four wide around the far turn, then closed well along the outside to be up for the show. KINDERGARDEN KID outrun early, swung wide for the stretch run and closed with a belated rally. GUYS REWARD stalked the pace into the stretch and finished willingly. MUTUAL TRUST (GB) chased the pace, was making a run at the lead when YUMMY WITH BUTTER came out and knocked him into SILVER MEDALLION, then gave way. UPTOWNCHARLYBROWN unhurried after hitting the gate at the start, gained some ground without threatening. TEAKS NORTH failed to menace. SANTIVA stalked the pace along the rail to past the eighth pole, then weakened. MAMBO MEISTER raced four wide around the far turn and was not a factor. HOOFIT (NZ) reserved racing along the rail, was attempting to rally along the inside when checked at the sixteenth pole and failed to recover. FLAT OUT stalked the pace three wide to the top of the stretch, then tired. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS INQUIRY AND A CLAIM OF FOUL BY THE RIDER OF MUTUAL TRUST, YUMMY WITH BUTTER WAS DISQUALIFIED AND PLACED SIXTH FOR INTERFERENCE TO THAT RIVAL IN THE STRETCH. A CLAIM OF FOUL BY THE RIDER OF MUTUAL TRUST AGAINST THE RIDER OF SILVER MEDALLION FOR ALLEGED INTERFERENCE IN THE STRETCH WAS NOT ALLOWED.
