JACK'S IN THE DECK sat within range throughout the opening half, was set down to a hard drive turning for home, overhauled the leader a short distance from the furlong grounds and kicked clear during the final sixteenth, kept busy to the end. TEAM SIX quickly took the lead, cut the pace slightly off the inside for most of the run around the turn, was called upon as he lead the field into the stretch, relinquished to the top one, held off a drifting rival to salvage second. TARPY'S GOAL widest on the turn, drifted out during the stretch drive, missed second. LARGE KAUFY hustled leaving the starting gate, was out sprinted nonetheless, remained under coaxing to keep pace, was set down from midway on the turn, angled three wide entering the stretch, lacked needed response. GETUPWITHTHESUN gave chase from the outside, bid briefly between rivals in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole before backing away. THREEANDDONEDAN bobbed at the break, raced off the inside and was through after going a half.
