For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental nomination payment of \$3,000 in addition to the entry and starting fees can be made at any time prior to the publication of weights. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. ARTEMIS AGROTERA took up the chase from the two path departing the backstretch having been asked for some run shortly after the first fraction been recorded, got teamed up with WILLET, was forced by the aforementioned rival to take the five path for entrance into the stretch, kicked into her best stride after getting straightened away, charged home with an amazing display of determination and speed to wrest away the decision in the last jump. LA VERDAD put to brisk hand urging, broke sharply, quickly established control, was put to a more relaxed hold after doing so and sent over to the rail, set a dazzling opening half, arrived at the quarter pole comfortably in the clear and was set down for the drive home, saw the lead dwindle down steadily once past the furlong grounds, got reeled in right at the wire. WILLET was placed along the rail shortly after the start, rode it to midway on the turn, got angled outward and raced side by side with the winner the rest of the way around the bend, angled four wide into the stretch, rallied between rivals from the furlong marker to the final seventy yards, willingly enough to garner the show award. MERRY MEADOW saved ground to no avail. CLASSIC POINT chased the pace from the two path, felt the whip past the three-eighths pole, tired. BRIDGEHAMPTON away well, was out-hustled by the second place finisher for command, stalked that opponent from the two path for nearly a half, initially pulling on the bit before giving way.
