WAVELL AVENUE stumbled at the start, recovered to chase just off the inside near the rear, came under coaxing midway on the turn, swung three wide for home under a drive, angled to the four path three-sixteenths from home, finished well to surge late and latch on the winner at the finish and garner the place honors. DAME DOROTHY lunged at the start getting away a beat slow, chased the pace along the inside coming under coaxing with five-sixteenths to run, spun just off the inside for home, angled out a path three-sixteenths from home, ran on through the final eighth to be along for the show honors while making no late headway on the front. ROOM FOR ME broke out at the start under hustling, prompted LA VERDAD two to three wide early on, got shaken off a bit three furlongs out and came under a ride in response, swung three wide for home giving chase in range, weakened in the late stages. CLASSIC POINT chased the pace three to four wide coming under urging three furlongs from home, angled five wide into upper stretch, drifted in under an off sided stick nearing the eighth pole and offered no response. WILLET chased the pace three to four wide from the rear under prolonged coaxing from the seven-sixteenths, angled six wide at the quarter pole, offered no response.
